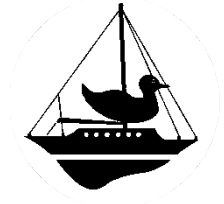

Speaking of the beach, we had a great turnout for the Bulkhead meeting last month. This will be a significant undertaking, and we need community input, so thanks to all that came out. Bayland Consultants fielded questions on the pros and cons of a stone reinforced shoreline vs. a living shoreline and what the differences are between the two. Here is a quick summary of where we are and where we still have to go. Keep in mind there is nothing short about this process, including making sure we as a community make an informed decision on what route we choose.

- Assess the wall's condition
- Discuss options with the County and State
- Conduct engineering study of options
- Present options to community
- Community chooses option and method of paying for it (special community meeting TBD)
- Solicit bids for design/construction
- Plan restoration of park (community action)
- Construction
- Restore Ulmstead Point Park!

As we get into the warmer season and begin planning and executing on home improvement projects small and large, please refer to the architectural guidelines and bylaws to allow ample time for any approvals you may require. For projects needing neighbor and board approvals, be mindful that the board meets on the first Wednesday of every month for such reviews, and it is difficult if not impossible to try to assemble a quorum outside of our monthly meetings. You are welcome to stay for as long as you like, but we try to take care of visitors' business first, so you do not have to spend your evening waiting to be heard.

The cold snaps should be coming to a close, so get out and enjoy this wonderful neighborhood we are all so fortunate to call home.

Broadneck Elementary students will be participating in the National Bike and Walk to School Day on Wednesday, May 10th, 2017.

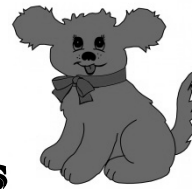
