From the President

A number of boats had loose lines and suffered relatively minor damage. Damage surely would have been much worse had these folks not gone out and secured those lines. Just another example of everyone looking after one another.

Dumpsters. Anne Arundel County Clean Up Program is delivering a dumpster to the BARN parking lot on Wednesday, June 13th. We missed our usual April weekend due to a mix-up at the County and will work to get our April weekend back next year. The dumpster is being provided for the disposal of large household trash and will be delivered to the Barn Parking Lot by noon on June 13th and removed by 8:00 a.m. on Friday, June 15th. If the initial dumpster is filled quickly, we can request it be swapped out for another; just email me and I can call the County. We've asked the County to place the dumpster in the center of the Barn Lot near the concrete parking blocks, so vehicles can drive around and access it from both sides. Disposal of the following is *prohibited*: junk automobiles, trailers, gas and propane tanks, tree trunks, oil drums or tanks, liquids, hazardous waste, boats, tires, logs, paint, and refrigerators or air conditioners. Do not leave any items that will not fit in the dumpster. Please be considerate and do not leave any messes around the dumpster.

NAUTICAL

Warmer weather brings more people and boats to our docks every day. Everyone should be familiar with our dock rules which are posted on Ulmstead's website. The rules are designed to allow all UCI members to safely enjoy our nautical facilities.

Fair skies and idyllic sunsets make it easy to forget how quickly the weather on the water can change. As most of our experienced boaters are aware and newcomers will soon find out, Dock 2 is very exposed to northerly winds. An early season storm has already caused damage to several boats at Dock 2. That will certainly not be the last storm of the year. Care should be taken when securing your boat in the slip. Sufficient sized nylon dock lines should be used. Extra caution should be used when securing a boat at Dock 2, especially in the outside slips. It is prudent to use extra dock lines, chaffing gear and mooring "snubbers" that absorb some of the effects of wind and waves. Boats generally ride better facing into the weather so where possible dock your boat "pointy end" out. These measures can reduce stresses on lines, cleats and piers and reduce the likelihood of damage to your boat or others. Check your boat and lines often. Slip assignments are posted at each dock. Let your neighbor know if you spot a problem with their boat.

All small boats stored on UCI property are required to display current UCI/Nautical stickers. At this time there are more small boats than there is space. In addition, there are unused boats that are collecting water and soon will become breeding grounds for mosquitoes. Boats without current stickers will be considered abandoned and may be removed.

Mark your calendars for the Nautical Department's Annual July 3rd Dock Party. Denise Zucco is again organizing one of Ulmstead's most popular events. For many years Ellis has been entertaining us at our dock parties. As a change, this year's musical entertainment will be provided by the band Pinkmans featuring Ulmstead's own, Kevin Pollock. As always, preparation and cleanup for this event requires considerable time and effort. If you can help with any of this, please contact Denise.

We are still awaiting permits to begin work on the demolition and reconstruction of Dock 1. Opposition by Dennis Deitch, a Forked Creek property owner and former Ulmstead Estates resident, has succeeded in delaying the approval process. According to the Md. Dept. of the Environment, as of now, he has not provided any grounds that would prevent them from issuing this permit, but his continued opposition has slowed the permit process.

As part of the agreement with the pier construction firm, they were to demolish and remove the floating dock that is next to the boat ramp at the same time as the demolition of Dock 1. We had hoped to have this done in the spring of this year. Unfortunately, because of the delay in obtaining a permit, the deteriorating condition of the floating dock will not allow us to wait for the Dock 1 demolition. UCI will probably incur additional costs since both demolitions cannot be done at the same time. Please observe the warning sign that is posted to keep off this dock until it can be removed.

Have a safe and enjoyable summer on and around our docks.
