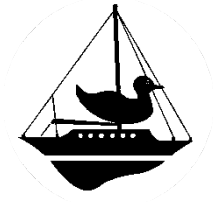

Spring is definitely here, and we are getting close to having a new sea wall/stone revetment at our beach park. By the time this letter is published, the wall should be 50% completed. I strongly remind the community to please stay away from the edge of the beach park behind the safety fence, and please watch your children as construction is ongoing. Our new sea wall should be completed soon. I can't wait.

In the 1950's, Ulmstead Point Farms became one of the largest Aberdeen Angus Cow breeding farms in the state. Our community barn was built to house the pedigree Aberdeen Angus Cows. Additionally, the stream behind the barn was dammed up to make a lake, and pig pens were located very close to where our community pool is today.

NAUTICAL

May brings an increased level of activity to our nautical facilities. Boats are arriving at their slips; walkers, runners, crabbers and fishermen will all be flocking to Ulmstead's docks. Please be courteous and observe the dock rules so that all UCI residents and their guests may safely enjoy our facilities.

Thanks to a tremendous effort by a group of our fellow nautical members, the kayak racks at Dock 2 have been completed and are open for business! We are trying to keep the larger craft, such as dinghies and canoes in the first 5 slots (top and bottom) closest to the little beach on the big rack. Please use the upper rack if you are able, so that ladies, youths, and seniors can have access to the lower racks. Work on the kayak rack at Dock 1 is scheduled to begin on Saturday, May 25th. The Boy Scouts will be constructing this rack. Thanks again to all who so generously contributed their expertise, time and hard work. Their effort has resulted in building a valuable community asset which will be enjoyed by many for years to come.

The permit to replace the dock at Lynch Point has been filed. We are currently soliciting bids for the new pier which should be completed this season. Also, we are currently looking for a replacement ice machine at Dock 2.

At present we have 85 boats at Docks 1 & 2, Lynch Point and the Floating Dock with more coming, and we still have available slips. We also have over 50 dinghies, canoes and kayaks stored on our racks. Ulmstead is fortunate to have such wonderful nautical facilities and our goal is to maintain and improve these facilities.

Kayaks, canoes and dinghies stored on UCI property require a current UCI Nautical sticker which can be obtained by contacting Barb Stone at 410-974-4313 or bstone1213@yahoo.com. The cost is \$25 for the first sticker and \$5 for each additional.

Trailers using the boat ramp require a current UCI Nautical sticker which can be obtained by contacting Lynne Andrews at 410-757-7578 or andrews691@verizon.net. The cost is \$100 for the first trailer and \$5 for each additional. The cost of a trailer sticker is included with slip and winter storage fees.
