## *From the President*

About 10 years ago, in his final *Weatherwane* letter to the community, former UCI president Andy Vernick identified three criteria by which to judge if a UCI presidency had been successful: “Ulmstead has not been attacked, we have money in the bank, and no one is suing us.” Well, as the wise bard Meatloaf sang nearly 40 years ago, “Two out of three ain’t bad.” And I am pleased to say that our next president, whomever that may be, will start his term without a lawsuit lingering. (If you missed the joint statement regarding the settlement of the lawsuit, look for the special December 16, 2016 issue of the *Weatherwane* online.)

That is not to say that there are no challenges ahead. The next Board of Directors will still face the challenge of repairing, renovating, and rebuilding the recreational facilities that help define our way of life here. Foremost among them remains the bulkhead at the beach park. The Board asked our engineer to do concept development for two alternatives: a 100% stone revetment and a living shoreline consisting of some combination of low-profile stone sills, tombolo-type breakwaters, and armored shoreline. Despite our best efforts, we have not been able to get concrete advice about relative costs and the availability of grant funding without the designs. I had hoped that these would be complete by the end of January. The Board will share them with the community and schedule a discussion when we get them.

Another challenge will always be the need to enforce our covenants and Bylaws, even when it is uncomfortable to do so. Every winter, we receive complaints about boats and campers being stored on the streets or where they are visible from the front of residences, in violation of the UCI Bylaws. These are sincere concerns, yet enforcing the rules often requires Board members to be the bad guys, which is a role none of us wants. In fact, the Bylaws assign this thankless task to the Executive Vice President -- perhaps that is why this important position has remained vacant for decades. The Board will police specific rule violations that are brought to our attention, but if you have a complaint, we encourage you to talk to your neighbor first. Few intend to offend. An alternative is the anonymous letter, such as the one submitted to the *Weatherwane* editor and included in this edition.

I have no doubt that the next Board will successfully manage these challenges. Thanks to the membership’s approval of the budget, the next Board will have the reserve funds to do so. It has long

been a source of pride to say that I live in a community where members recognize the value of its assets and are willing to vote overwhelmingly to dedicate their hard-earned money to its upkeep, without rancor. Thank you.

And thanks to UCI's officers, Department chairs, and other volunteers, the next Board will continue to have the support they need to get the job done. The most important and enduring lesson I have learned as president is that our Department chairs are truly the unsung heroes of UCI. They are the volunteers most frequently in contact with members, they are on the front line when problems occur, and they often have more institutional knowledge than the Board itself. I want to express my deepest appreciation to them — Pat Shay, Lynne Andrews, Brian Poole, Kathy Pruissen, Renee Kardash, Bryan Templeton, Kathy Jacob, and Al Homans — for a job well done.

As I prepare to return to a more quiet life — yeah, OK, not likely, but I can dream — I want to offer gratitude to several others who have contributed in ways great and greater this past year. Thank you to my fellow Board members for their dedication to the neighborhood, their tolerance of long meetings, and for stepping in when my attention was pulled elsewhere. Thanks especially to Nancy Kennerly for serving with me these past three years and always having her finger on the pulse of the neighborhood. Best wishes to you as you move on from here. Past presidents Kathleen McCoun, Dave McCoun, Ken Paquin, Lois Findlay, and Tim Hooper were always willing to offer advice, guidance, and a helping hand when needed. Mary Grund and Renee Kelly kept us fiscally responsible; Hannah Goldstein and Colleen Ireland ensured that our records would be readily available for future needs; Meaghan Rosso brought neighbors closer together (366 and counting on Nextdoor!). Thank you also to those members who offered a handshake or sent me emails of encouragement; your support meant a lot. Finally, thank you to my wonderful wife Stephanie Collier for putting up with the late hours, lost vacation days, and storage boxes in the living room that this presidency required. I love you.

Please join me and your neighbors at the annual meeting on Saturday, February 11<sup>th</sup>, where we will hear about UCI's many successes this past year and discuss plans for the new year. We will also elect two new Board members to replace Nancy and myself. It has been an honor to have your trust and serve you as UCI President. Thank you!

## Anonymous Letter Submitted to the Weathervane

[Lightly edited]

Having lived in Ulmstead for several years, I feel I must express my concern over how we the Members of the community are showing a disregard for our Bylaws. This is especially disturbing having just gone thru the recent court case. I believe it is important we have these guidelines and we should ALL abide by them.

This brings me to the point of my letter to the Board and the *Weathervane*.

As stated in Article VII Section i thru m of the Bylaws:

- i. Boats, trailers, campers and other such items shall be stored in garages or may be stored on residential lots in back of the residence and to the degree possible consistent with the topography of the lot, not generally to be visible from the street;
- j. Garden equipment, including machines, garbage and trash receptacles, ladders, outside clothes lines and poles shall be maintained and stored so as to be out of public view when not in use. This provision does not apply to garbage and trash receptacles on days when trash and garbage are scheduled for collection;
- k. No air conditioning unit external to the residence shall be installed or maintained on the front or street side of the house;
- l. No storm windows other than metal and glass or wood and glass shall be installed or maintained;
- m. Unlicensed motor bikes and mini bikes shall not be permitted within the community except as authorized by applicable State and County laws. The enforcement of these laws shall rest with the appropriate Anne Arundel County officials;

There are numerous boats, RVs, trailers, and prizes only an owner could love parked on the street and in driveways visible from the street - all in violation of our Bylaws. I shudder to think what our neighborhood will look like if this continues. More boats, cars, and maybe commercial vehicles on the streets and in the driveways is not only an eyesore but a violation of the community Bylaws.

Our Bylaws were established to protect all of our interests and are what has help set Ulmstead apart from other communities in the area. I know that in wanting to be a good neighbor it is difficult to report a neighbor who is in violation. However, I continue to hear many complain to others about these violations. In the interim of their being a posted procedure on how to report such a violation, I suggest that if you see a violation on your street and don't want to confront the violator, report it to the board anonymously and have them send a notice to the violator. This makes it non-personal. And frankly this is a non-personal issue. You are not saying you don't like your neighbor. If you are like me, you simply want your neighbor to stop violating community Bylaws. Keeping our Bylaws makes for a good neighborhood and good neighbors.
